### COSTUMING PROFILE

This is the information required to begin constructing costume design and eventually order team attire. It allows us to see the potential team as a whole, and what range of shapes we are working with. ALL shapes are beautiful and accepted, but information is key to designing great costumes.

Please don't underestimate your sizes. We are all different shapes, and we simply want dancers to look and feel good with their natural figures.

15. Full Body Photo \*

Please dress in form-fitting practice attire.

16. Dancer Height \*

Measured in feet and inches, please choose the closest option to your true height

17. Dancer Weight \*

In pounds, your average or typical weight (used for ordering tights)

18. Bust Measurement (in inches) \*

Measure the bust line at the fullest part of your chest. Pull the tape as tight as you can without changing the shape of your breasts. While you are being measured, your arms should be at your side and relaxed.

19. Waist Measurement (in inches) \*

Wrap the measuring tape around your torso, at the smallest part of your waist. Typically this is an inch or so above your belly button and is also known as the natural waistline.

20. Hips Measurement (in inches) \*

Wrap the tape measure around the fullest part of your seat area; the hips and buttocks. Keep the tape measure parallel to the floor.

21. Inseam Measurement (in inches) \*

The longest length on the inside of your leg from crotch to ankle.

22. Waist to Knee Measurement (in inches) \*

Measure down the side of your body from the waistline to the middle of the knee.

23. Canadian Dress Size (average or typical size) \*

Understandably, different shops offer different sizing and your size may vary from store to store. Please

select the size that you feel the most comfortable in.
